

PRINCIPLES FOR PRICING POLLUTION.

Our research suggests a carbon price must:

- Make it possible for individuals to switch to alternatives, and desirable for companies and businesses to innovate and operate in line with a low-carbon agenda.
- 2. Protect those on low and modest incomes from substantial rises in costs.
- 3. Prevent carbon leakage and associated job loss.



HOW IS IT GOING?

The UK Government has agreed to:

- 1. Explore extending carbon pricing across the two thirds of our economy not yet covered
- 2. Review 'free allocations' within the UK ETS to ensure they're effectively driving rather than stymying decarbonisation
- 3. Champion multilateral engagement with regards to Border Carbon Adjustments in order to address carbon leakage

Statement: The UK must drive an ambitious carbon pricing agenda at COP26


Ahead of hosting the UN climate summit in Glasgow in 2021, the UK Government must lead unprecedented action against climate change, both at home and abroad.

A core part of this focus must be <u>(arbon pricing</u> -an indispensable part of any strategy for efficiently reducing the production of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions.

Currently only 22% of global GHGs are 'priced', meaning that the vast majority of the emissions responsible for global warming are being released freely into the atmosphere. What's more, the average global carbon price of \$2USD per tonne of CO.e is significantly lower than that required to drive the global transition away from the use of fossil fuels.

This is having enormous health, socioeconomic and environmental impacts - including on progress against the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) - and needs to change if we want to tackle our addiction to fossil fuels, and achieve the ambitious temperature targets laid out in the Garis Agreement.)
